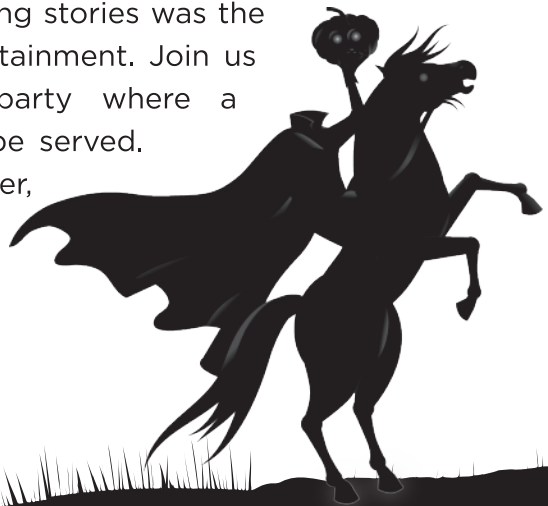
From the Director

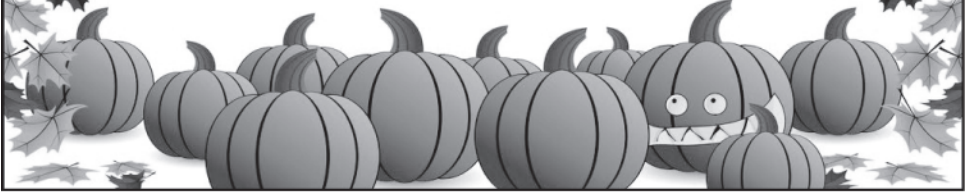
